

4 Ways to Evaluate My Leadership Integrity

AM I WORSHIPING WITH MY FAMILY?

PSALM 145:4

One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts.

EXAMPLE OF IMMEDIACY

Isaiah 39:5-8

Then Isaiah said to Hezekiah, “Hear the word of the Lord of hosts: *Behold, the days are coming, when all that is in your house, and that which your fathers have stored up till this day, shall be carried to Babylon. Nothing shall be left, says the Lord. And some of your own sons, who will come from you, whom you will father, shall be taken away, and they shall be eunuchs in the palace of the king of Babylon.*” Then said Hezekiah to Isaiah, “The word of the Lord that you have spoken is good.” For he thought, “*There will be peace and security in my days.*”

EXAMPLE OF INTEGRITY #1 - BELIEF

Romans 4:2-3

For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but *not before God. 3 For what does the Scripture say? “Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness.”*

EXAMPLE OF INTEGRITY #2 - GIVING

Genesis 14:17-20

After his return from the defeat of Chedorlaomer and the kings who were with him, the king of Sodom went out to meet him at the Valley of Shaveh (that is, the *King's Valley*). *And Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine. (He was priest of God Most High.) And he blessed him and said,*

*“Blessed be Abram by God Most High,
Possessor of heaven and earth;
and blessed be God Most High,
who has delivered your enemies into your hand!”*
And Abram gave him *tenth of everything*.

EXAMPLE OF INTEGRITY #3 - HERITAGE

Genesis 15:16-21

And they shall come back here in the fourth generation, for *the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet complete.*”

When the sun had gone down and it was dark, behold, a smoking fire pot and a flaming torch passed between these pieces. On that day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying, “*To your offspring I give this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates, the land of the Kenites, the Kenizzites, the Kadmonites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Rephaim, the Amorites, the Canaanites, the Girgashites and the Jebusites.*”

EXAMPLE OF INTEGRITY #4 - PRAYER

Genesis 18:22-33

So the men turned from there and went toward Sodom, but Abraham still stood before the Lord. Then Abraham drew near and said, “Will you indeed sweep away the righteous with the wicked?”
