II Thessalonians 1:3–5

We ought always to thank God for you, brothers, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love every one of you has for each other is increasing.

Therefore, among God's churches we boast about your perseverance and faith in all the persecutions and trials you are enduring. All this is evidence that God's judgment is right, and as a result you will be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are suffering.



Suffering Helps Us Grow (vv. 3-5)

- ❑ Reputation of Faith, Hope and Love (I Thess. 1:3)
- ❑ Growing in Patience (v. 4)
 - Romans 5:3
 - I Peter 4:12-19

We should accept the suffering, yield to God's will, and by faith continue to stand true, then the suffering will cause us to grow.



II Thessalonians 1:6–10

God is just: He will pay back trouble to those who trouble you and give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well. This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the majesty of his power on the day he comes to be glorified in his holy people and to be marveled at among all those who have believed. This includes you, because you believed our testimony to you.



Standing True During Suffering (vv. 6-10)

1 Peter 2:15 - "For it is God's will that by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk of foolish men."

1 Peter 2:19 - "For it is commendable if a man bears up under the pain of unjust suffering because he is conscience of God."

1 Peter 2:21 - "To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in His steps."



II Thessalonians 1:11–12

With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may count you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may fulfill every good purpose of yours and every act prompted by your faith.
